

DUCHESS. I'm impervious to flattery. (*She hits ball and exits left followed by PARCHESTER.*) Come Parchester.

SIR JOHN. You can't let her do this to you.

SALLY. But she's right. Bill belongs here I don't.

SIR JOHN. You must stand up to her. Show her who's boss.

SALLY. She already knows who's boss. She is.

SIR JOHN. Leave it to me. (*DUCHESS enters down left in search of SIR JOHN.*) I'll tell the old witch -- (*Sees her.*) -- witch, which reminds me; it's my shot I think.

[MUSIC CUE #14: TAKE IT ON THE CHIN]

(*SIR JOHN follows the DUCHESS out left. SALLY starts to follow, thinks better of it, then begins to weep, softly. SIR JASPER, who has been watching from upstage, crosses to her.*)

SIR JASPER. Are you all right? Are you crying?

SALLY. No, I'm okay. People often look like they're crying when really they're sort of laughing.

SIR JASPER. Eh?

SALLY. I'm laughing.

SIR JASPER. What?

SALLY. I'm laughing.

(ELEC CUE: 45)
